The position will work closely with the Director of Information Technology and senior leadership.

Design, develop, and maintain ETL (Extract, Transform, Load) pipelines for importing data from multiple sources into SQL Server.

Ensure data accuracy, consistency, and integrity during ingestion and integration processes.

Automate routine data ingestion and integration tasks using scripts and scheduling tools (e.g., SSIS, Python, or other ETL tools).

Monitor and troubleshoot data pipeline performance and resolve issues in a timely manner.

Write and optimize SQL queries to extract data from SQL Server for reporting purposes.

Create stored procedures, views, and functions for efficient data retrieval and manipulation.

Develop and maintain detailed technical documentation for database schemas, queries, and processes.

Support ad-hoc data requests from various departments.

Design, develop, and maintain interactive dashboards using tools like Power BI, Tableau, or equivalent.

Ensure dashboards are user-friendly and meet business needs by working closely with stakeholders.

Create data models and visualizations that provide actionable insights and key performance indicators (KPIs).

Continuously improve and optimize existing dashboards based on user feedback and evolving business needs.
